## "The-Pensions-Net-Work comes to Scotland"

The-Pensions-Net-Work (TPNW) was set up in 2006 to meet the needs of senior practitioners in the pensions and employee benefits industry. Four meetings a year are held to enable members to meet, discuss industry issues and exchange new ideas with their peers in a non-competitive, relaxed and informal environment. Up to now locations have typically been within 50 miles of central London.

Our meetings are held under the Chatham House Rule to encourage open debate, new learning and thinking. Usually there are six main speakers with ample time allowed for discussion after each presentation. There are also several networking opportunities. Meetings generally start at 5.30pm on Thursday evening finishing at lunch time on Friday. Included in the cost is dinner and overnight accommodation on the Thursday, breakfast and lunch on the Friday.

The objective is open, relaxed and constructive debate in an informal environment, allowing the opportunity for members to interact with their peers, colleagues and friends. With this in mind, the numbers attending are limited to around 40.
